## Newsletter - September 2008

A brief update as we commence our 2008/09 season.

### Autumn Production      performances 10<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup> December 2008

Our autumn production is the pantomime 'Aladdin', directed by Mike Sparks. We held a couple of read through evenings in July, allowing Mike to cast most of the roles. A production planning meeting was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> September for all cast and crew. Everyone notified that they have been given a part should collect copies of script changes as soon as possible.

The first rehearsal will be on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> September when the cast will start to read through in character. This does not mean that anyone else interested in helping in any way should not come along. There are some nice little walk on parts yet to be assigned.

Rehearsal in the following week will only be on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> but after that we will be reverting to our usual process of Mondays and Wednesdays at 8 pm. Some Saturday rehearsals will also be mixed in, plus the likelihood of other evenings if things don't go strictly to plan. A full rehearsal schedule will be available from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> September.

All this pre-supposes the fact that we can find sufficient backstage staff. The situation is serious because at present we lack a Musical Director, a Stage Manager and a Props person. If anyone is interested in helping with any of these roles Mike would appreciate a call.

### Easter Production      performances 7<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup> April 2009

Following on from "The Inn Keeper's Tale", "The Soldiers Tale", "The Gardener's Tale" and "Peter's Tale", Mike has yet another script up his sleeve for our next touring Easter Production. This will be rehearsed in parallel with the Spring Production.

### Spring Production      performances 14<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> May 2009

The committee have yet to make a decision on the Spring production. If you have a suggestion for a possible play, please pass it on to a committee member.

## Annual General Meeting

The AGM of the Guild Players will take place on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> September, starting at 8 pm. Please make every effort to attend **PROMPTLY**. We try to keep the meeting short as it will be followed by a rehearsal for the autumn production.
